A school that wants to show the full breadth of what its students can achieve, and give every pathway equal weight.

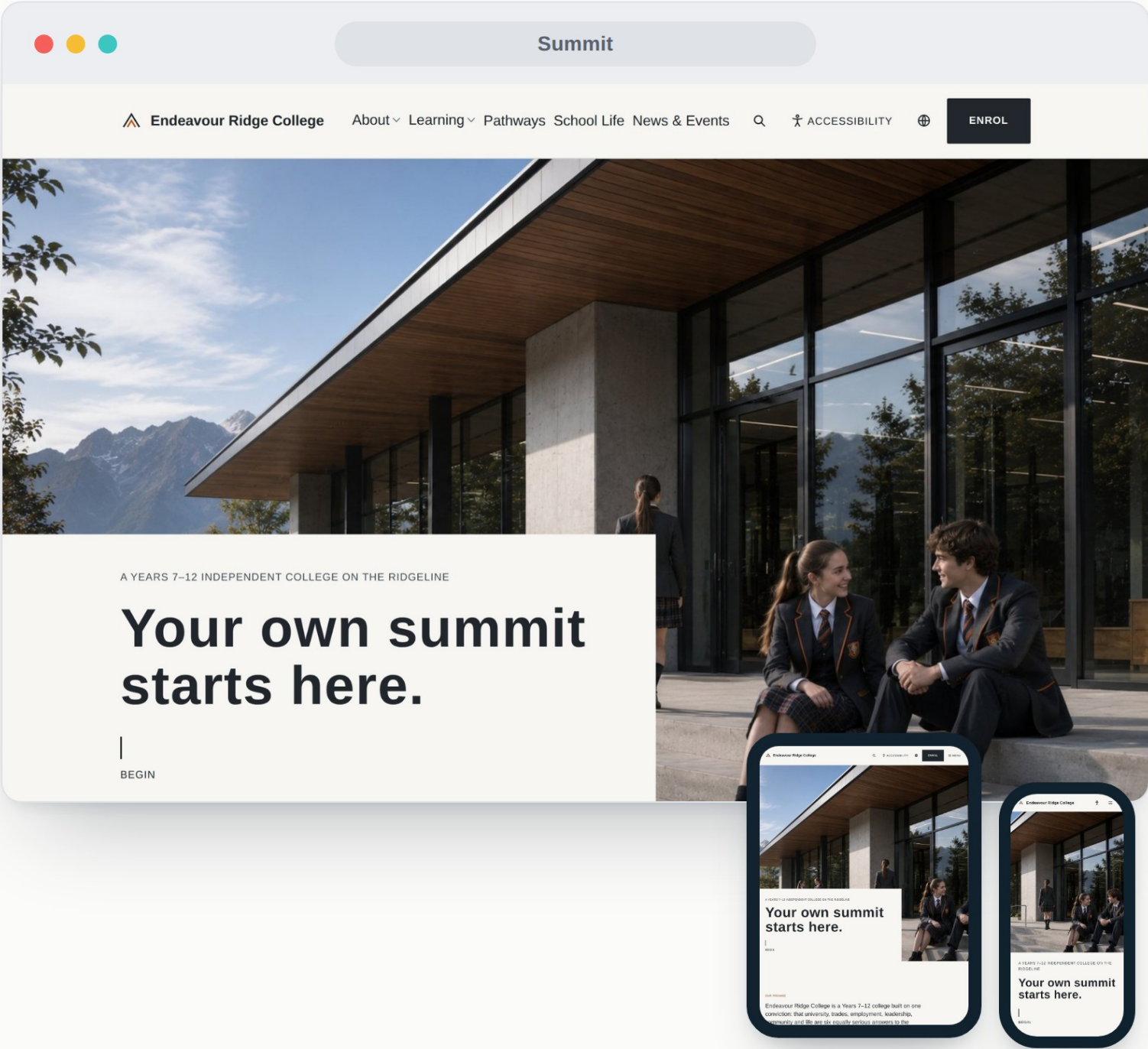

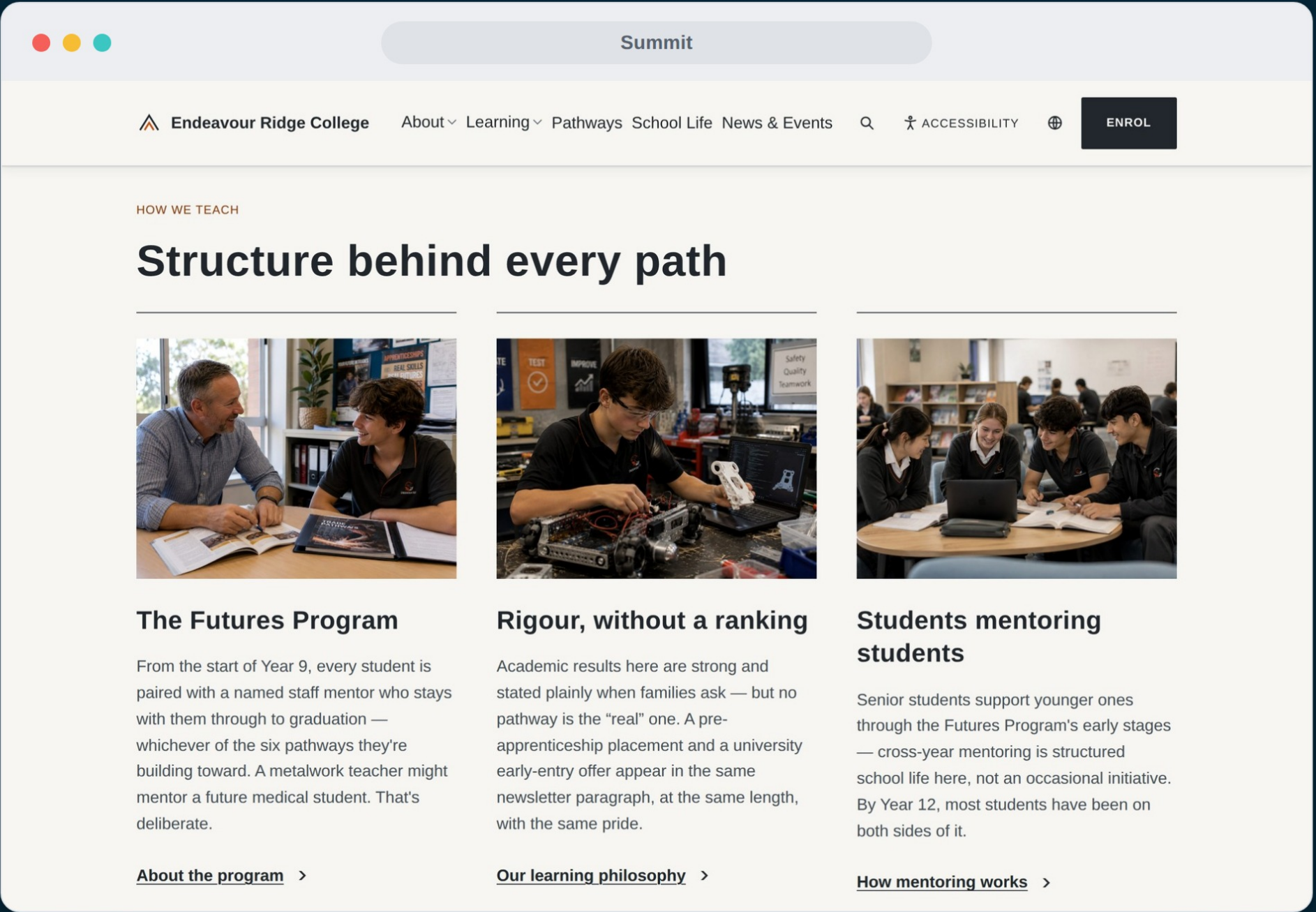

A school or early-learning community that wants families to feel welcomed and reassured, and to meet the specific people who will know their child.

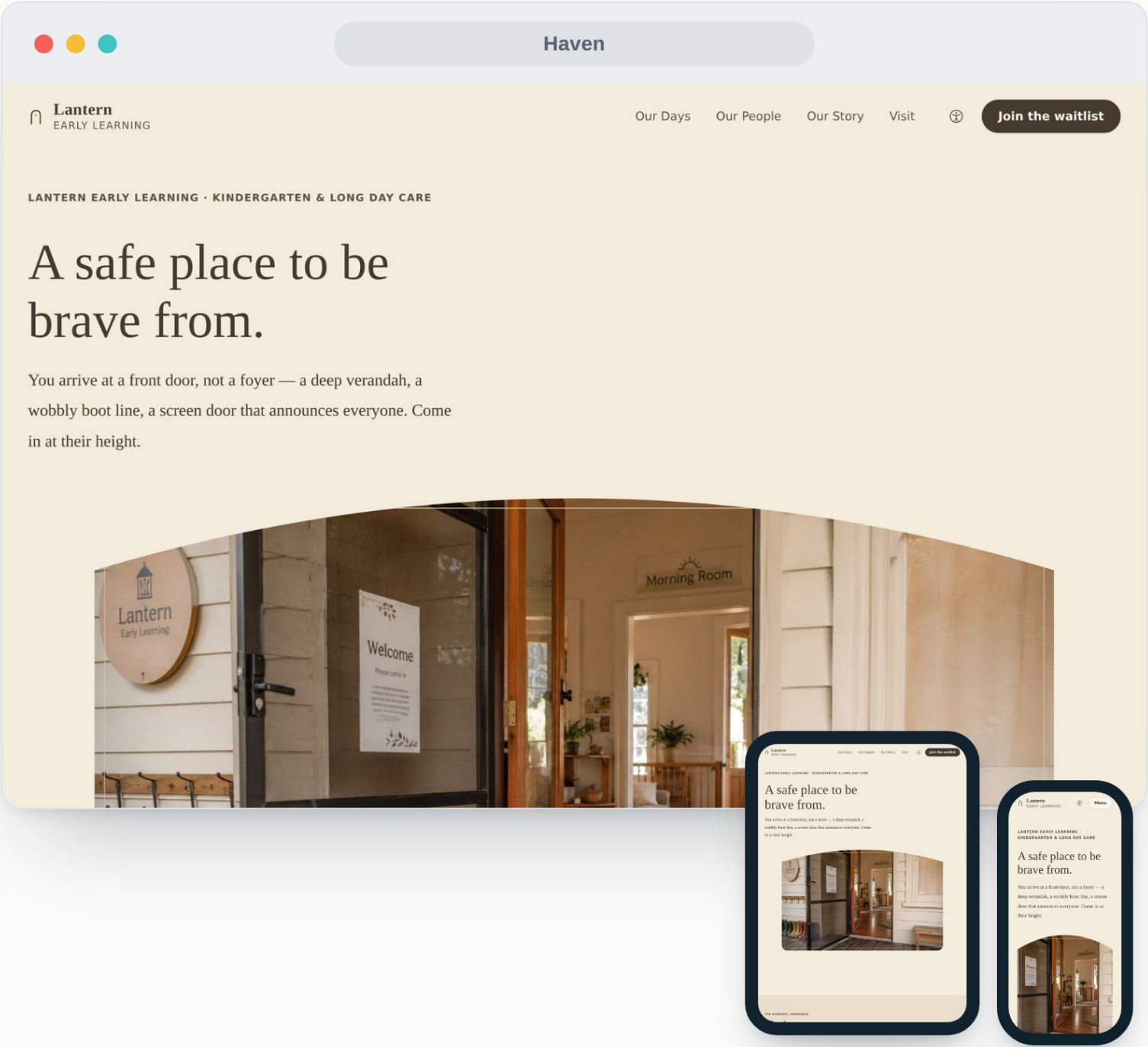
THE FEELING IT CREATES

WCAG-aligned and built for every family — clear and navigable on any device.

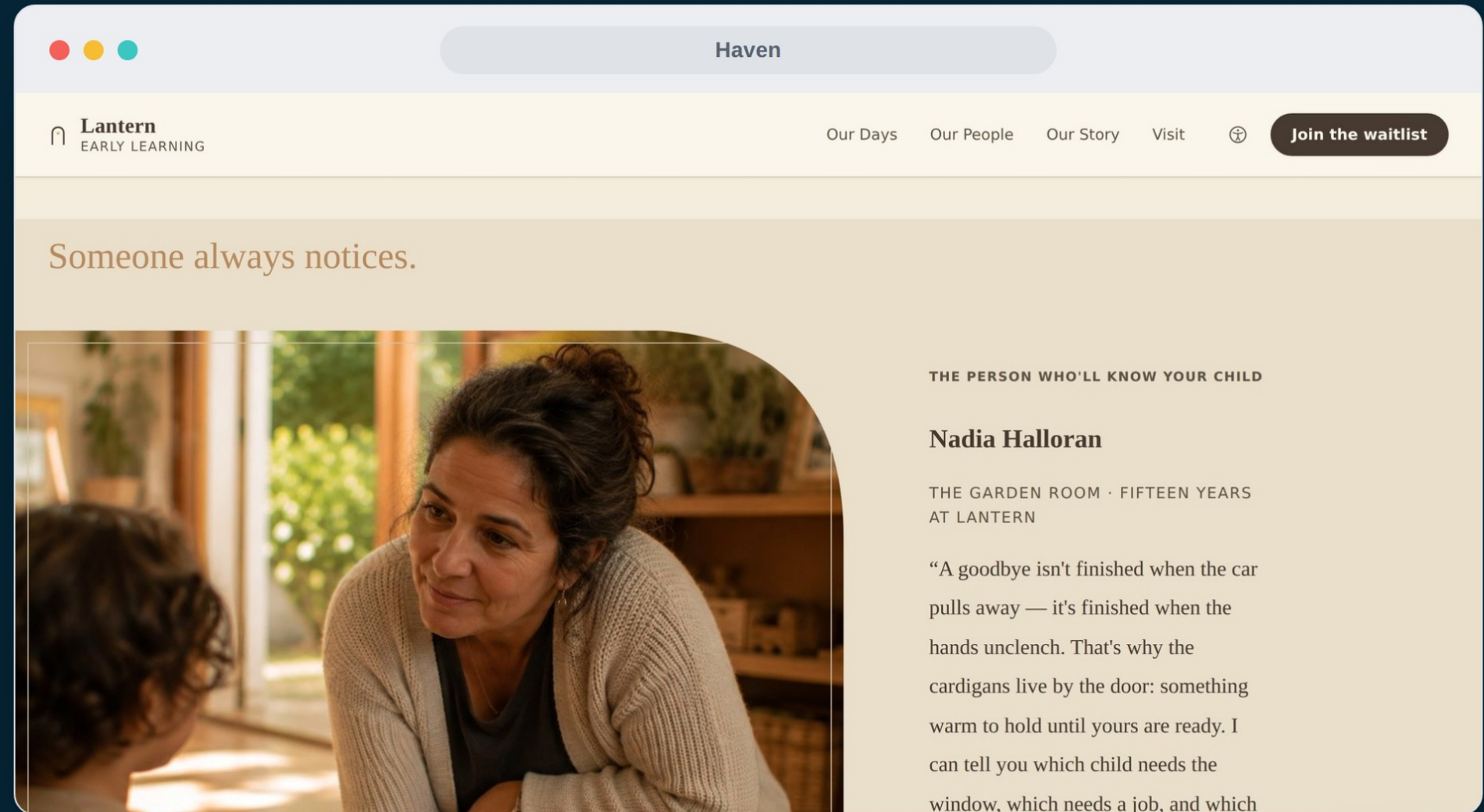

A school with a strong academic identity and a clear sense of character, that wants families to feel its ambition and its warmth in the same breath.

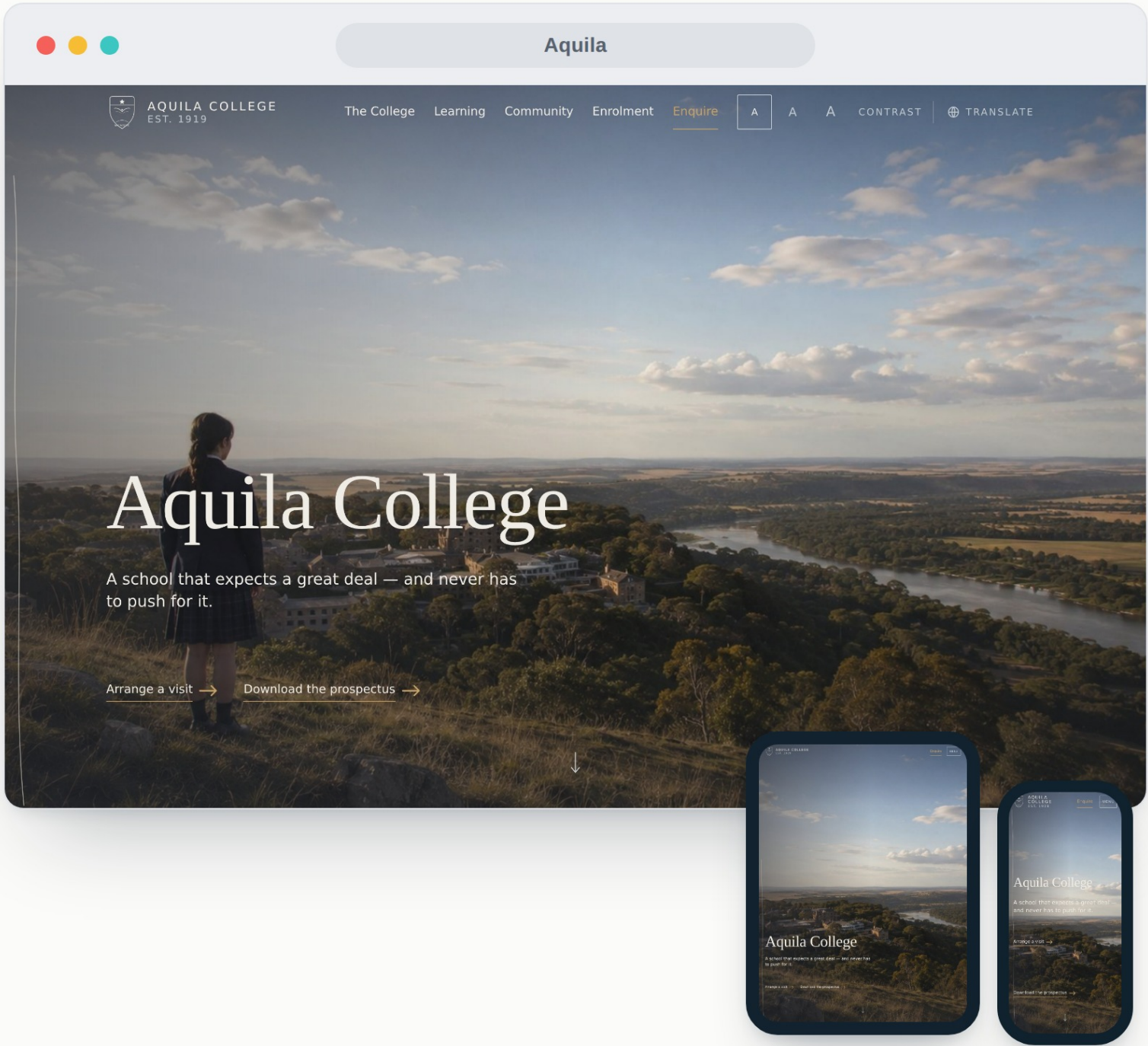
THE FEELING IT CREATES

One click puts every page in the languages your community reads.

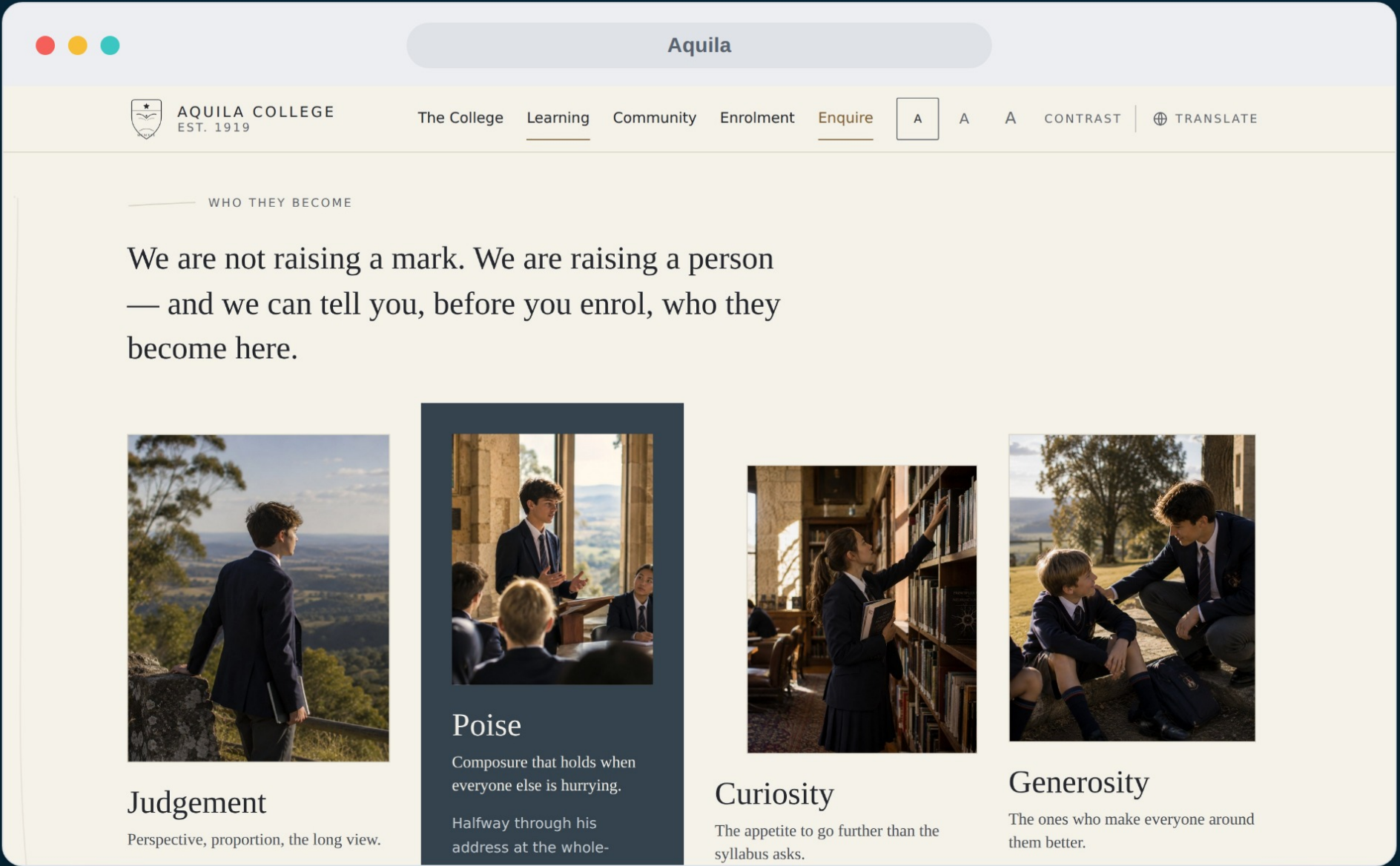

A close-knit school with strong community roots and a hands-on, values-led philosophy, that wants families to feel welcomed, grounded and unhurried.

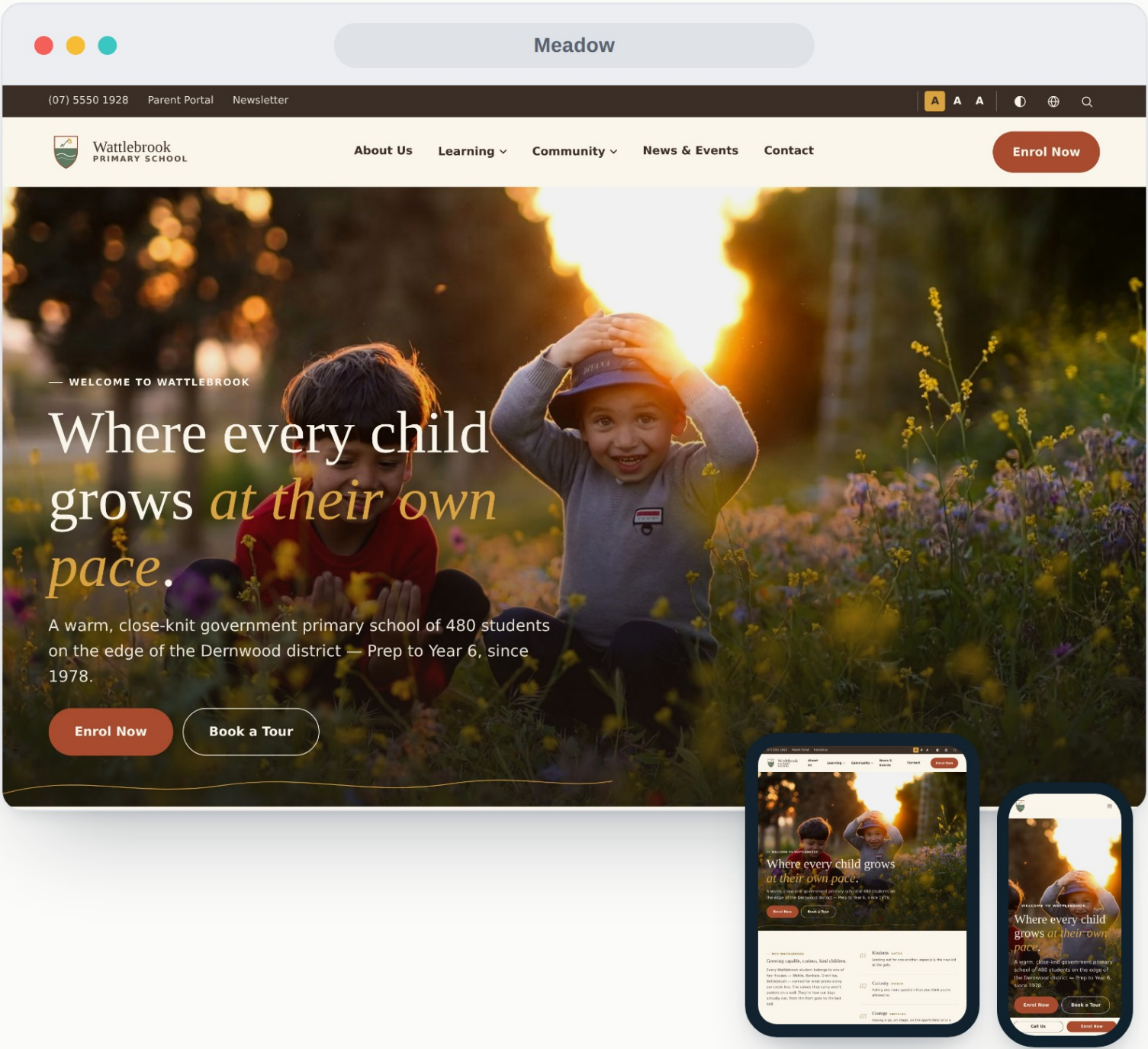

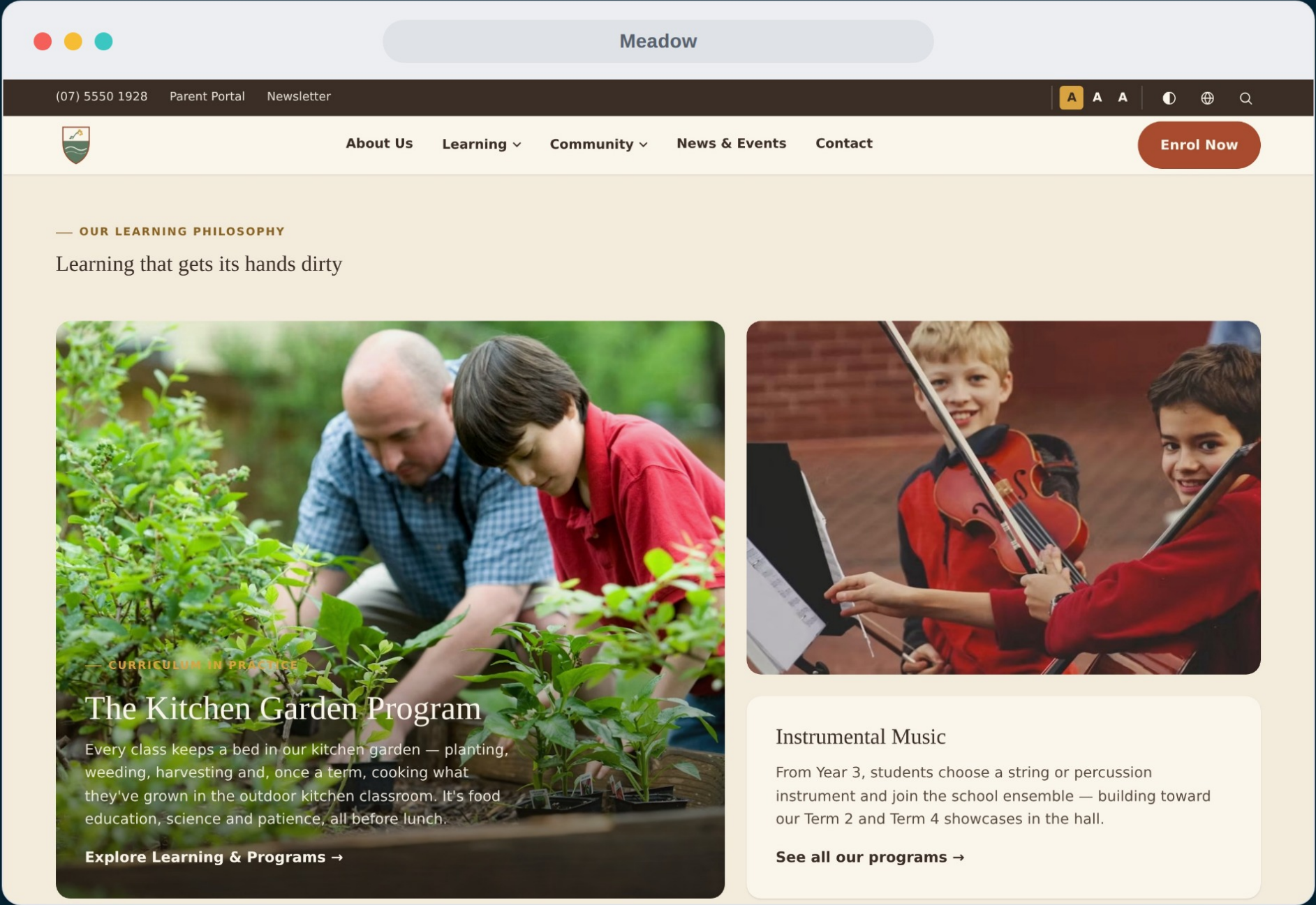

An established school with deep community roots and a long story to tell, that wants families to feel the weight and warmth of its history.

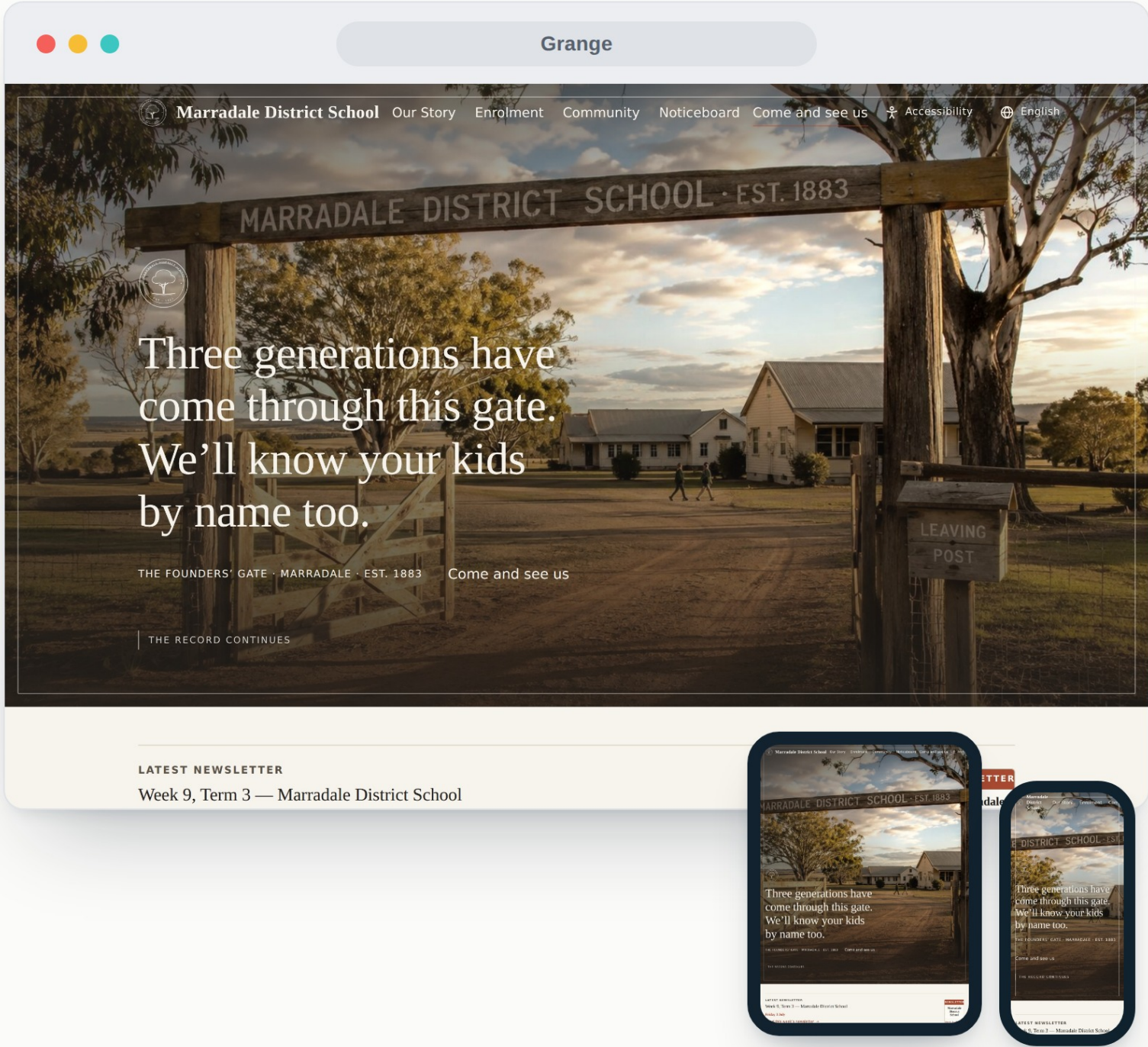
THE FEELING IT CREATES

Staff update pages, news and events themselves — no technical skill needed.

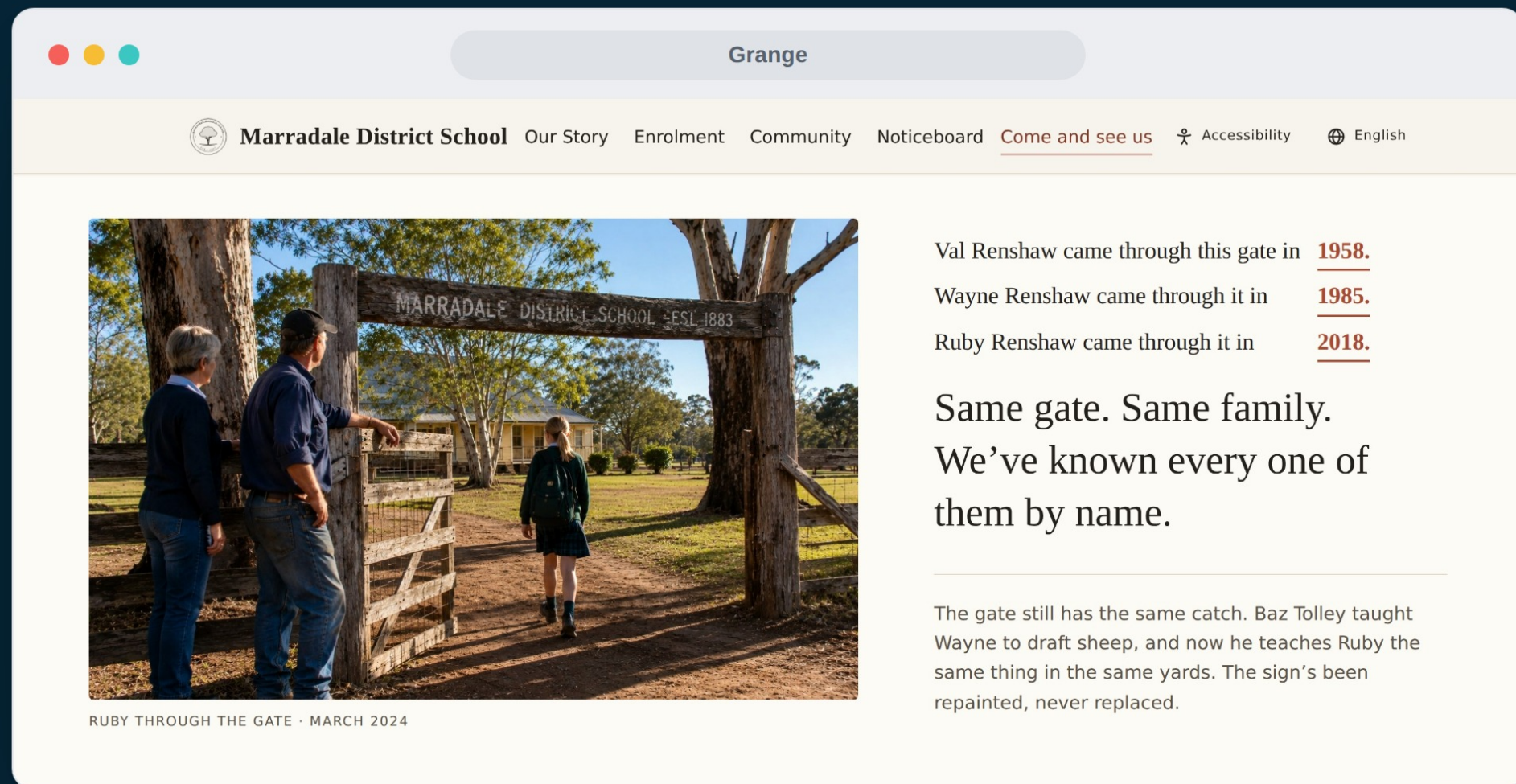

A school that carries a child across many years or stages, and wants families to feel the value of a single, continuous journey rather than a series of separate schools.

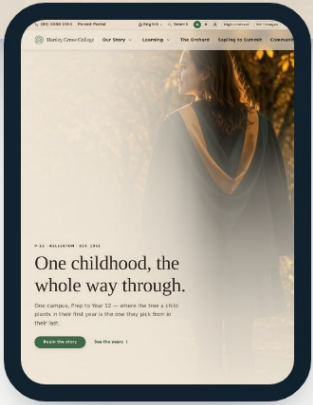
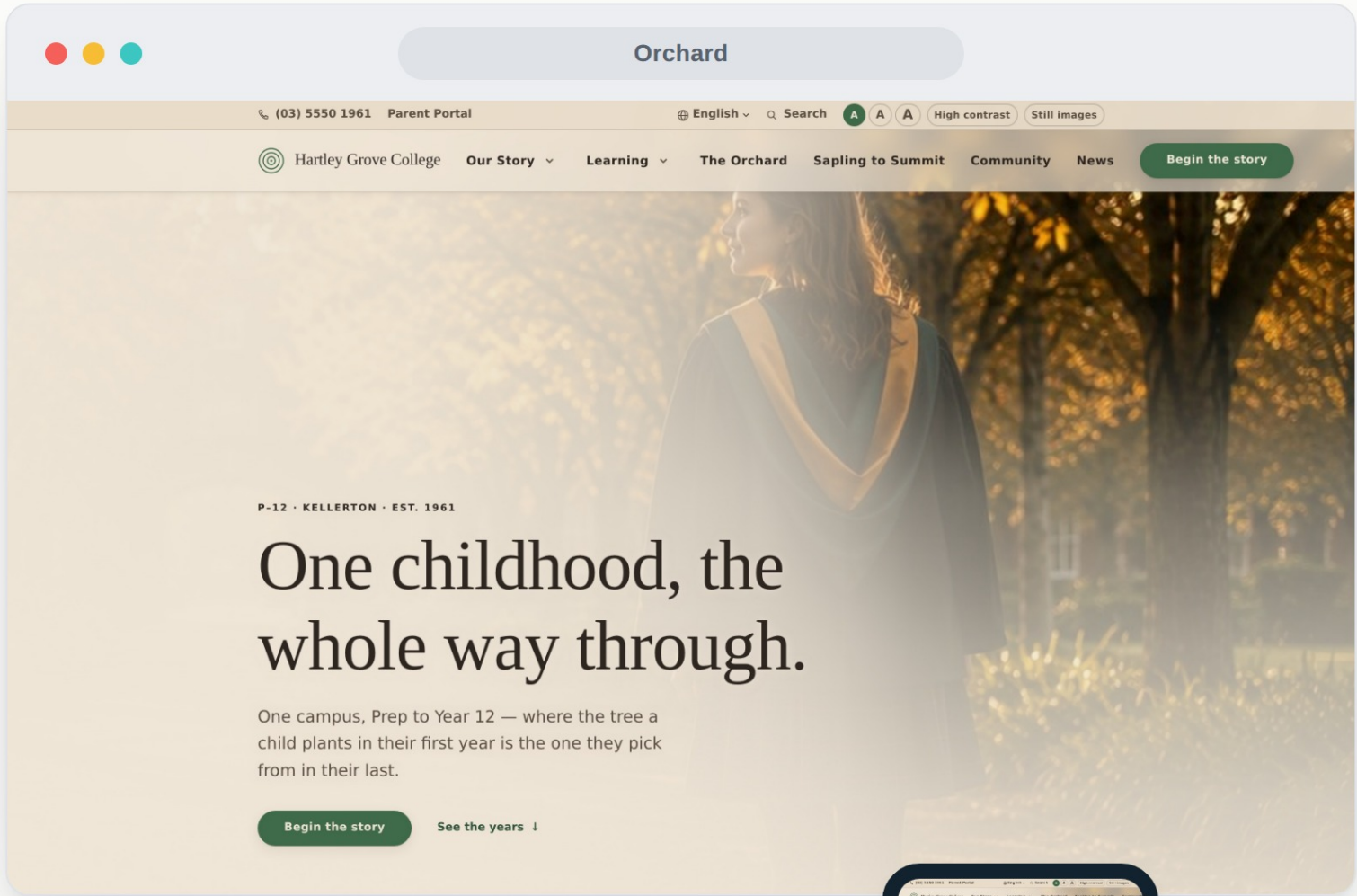

New features and improvements arrive automatically, for the life of the site.

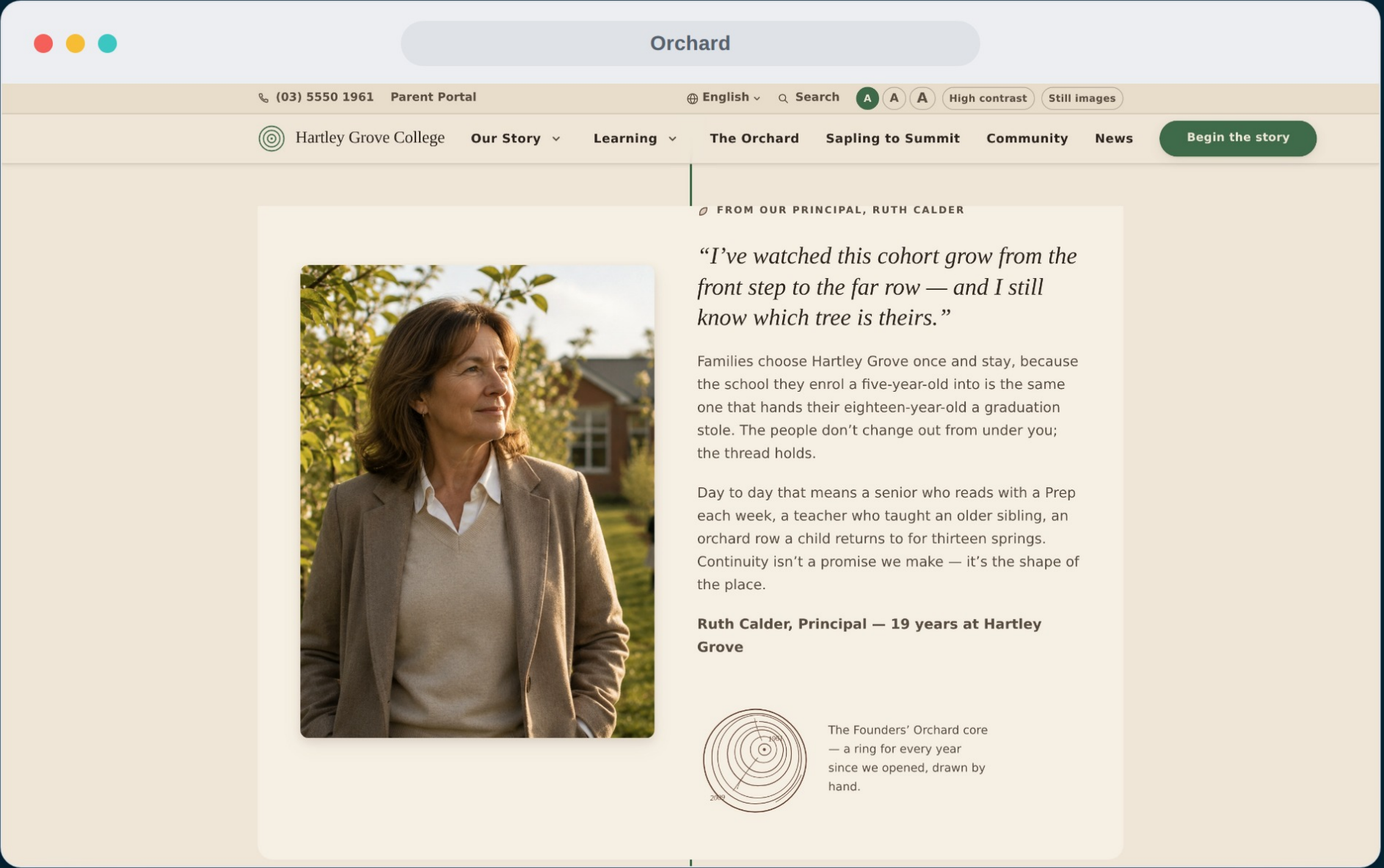

A complete, contemporary school whose applied, real-world learning is a leading reason families choose it, and that would rather show evidence than make claims.

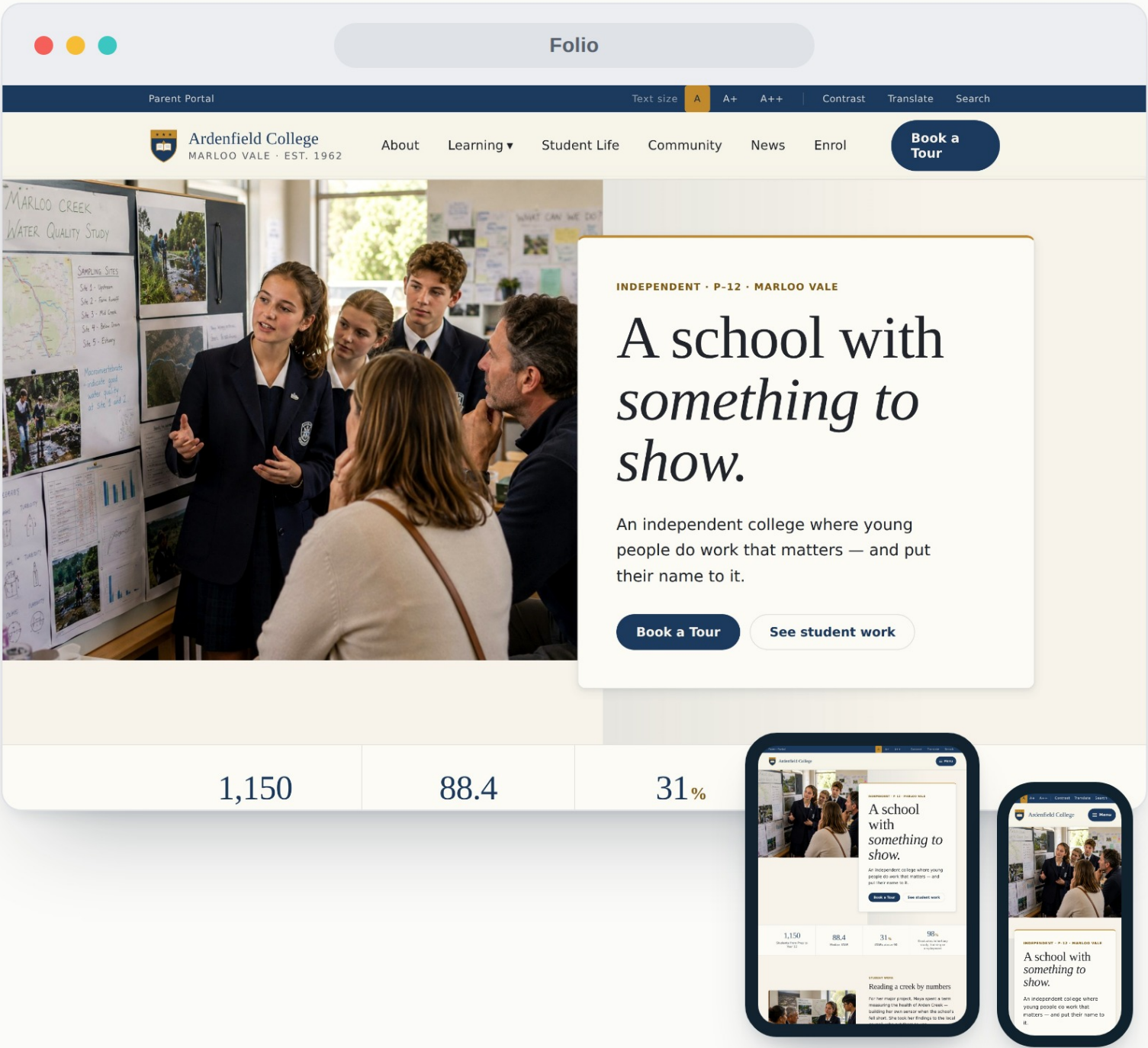

Every page structured to be found first when your community searches.

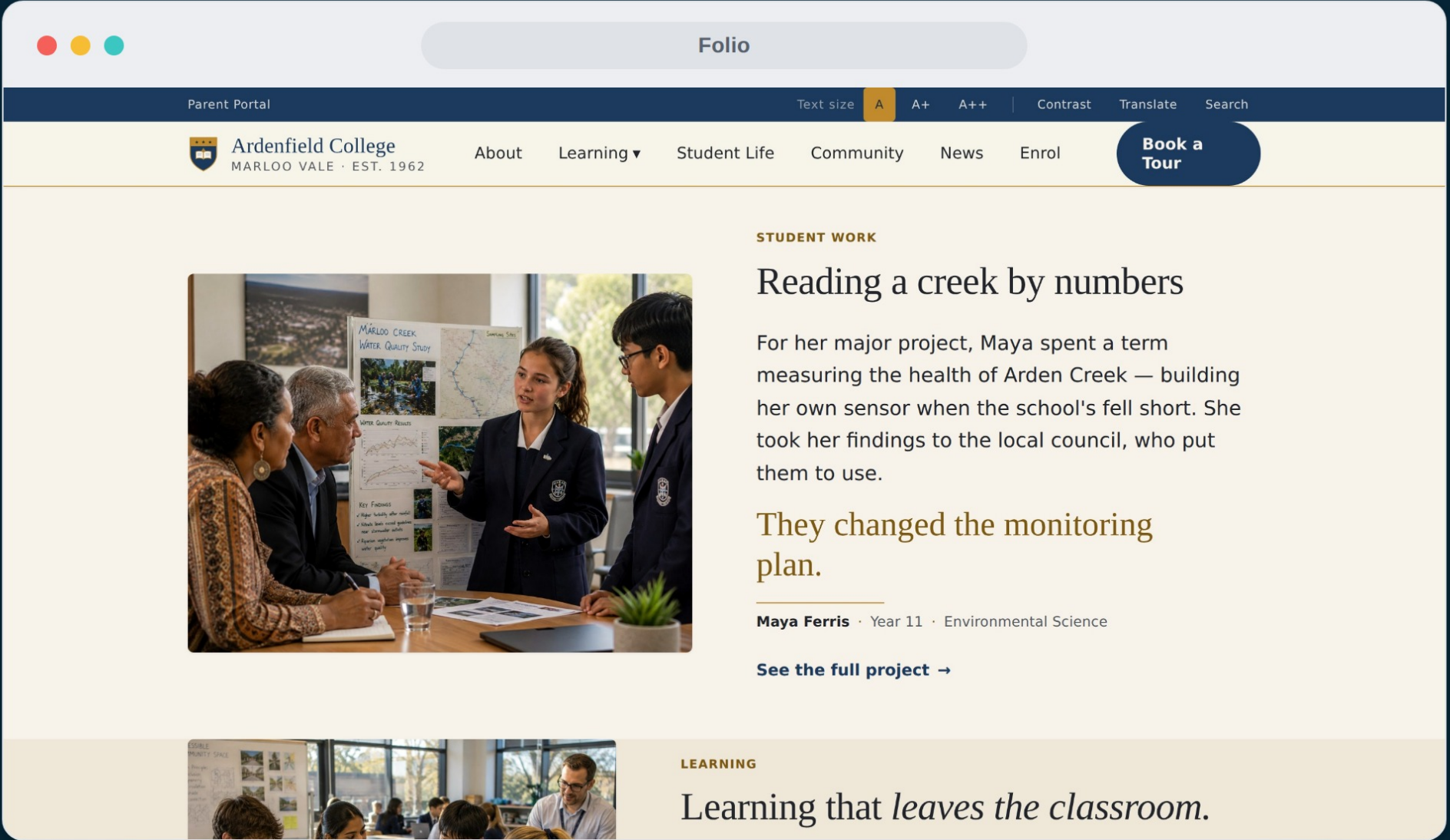
